On January 6, 2011 The Association of Latvian Chemical and Pharmaceutical Enterprises (LAKIFA) signed a contract No.APA-L-10-0025 with the Latvian Investment and Development Agency (LIAA) to implement a project "Rise of qualification of those employed in the Latvian chemical industry and its branches, increase of competitiveness on the labor market and among the entrepreneurs." Project No. APA/1.3.1.1.1/10/02/009

The aim of the project is, with the direct participation of industry enterprises, to increase qualification of their employees in most important areas, and to establish a human resource base founded on the knowledge and experience in Latvian Chemical and related sectors.

This program will contribute to process productivity, promoting entrepreneurship and labor market development, improving industry competitiveness in domestic and international markets.

The project applicant and the leading partner is LAKIFA who, from 2009 to 2010, has successfully implemented the EU co-financed Chemical industry training projects amounting to 332 905 Ls. (473 681 EUR).

LAKIFA implements the project in cooperation with more than 40 companies in chemical and related branches, including "Cytex Latvia".

The project will be realized until July 26, 2013, organizing trainings in the following areas: industrial engineering, management, computer science, engineering and technologies, manufacturing and processing, labor safety and protection, language programs.

The project is being implemented within the frame of the EU Structural Funds Program "Support the training to promote entrepreneurs competitiveness - support the training organized in partnerships".
